AIR TRAVEL

San Francisco is accessible through the San Francisco International Airport (SFO) and the Oakland International Airport (OAK).

<u>San Francisco International Airport (SFO)</u> is located a short distance (approximately 13 miles) from the Hilton San Francisco Union Square. Visit <u>www.flysfo.com</u> for information. <u>Oakland International Airport (OAK)</u> is located approximately 19 miles from the Hilton San Francisco Union Square. Visit <u>www.iflyoak.com</u> for information.

Depending on your point of origin, your schedule, or your budget, you may find a better flight to the Bay Area landing in Oakland.

GETTING FROM THE SAN FRANCISCO AND OAKLAND AIRPORTS TO THE CONFERENCE HOTEL

SHARED RIDE SERVICES (UBER, LYFT, WINGZ)

SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (SFO)

Lyft and Uber Domestic pickups are located on Level 5 of the Domestic Garage. Domestic drop offs back at the Airport from the Hotel are at the Domestic Terminal curbside. Uniformed coordinators are stationed at each zone from 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. to assist guests with questions or concerns.

Each Domestic Terminal has a corresponding pickup area in the garage core as follows:

- Terminal 1 A/B & B
- Terminal 2 C & D
- Terminal 3 E, F & F/G

Wingz pick-up area is located at the Departures level of the Domestic Terminals:

- Terminal 1, Door 4
- Terminal 2, Door 4 and 5
- Terminal 3, Door 11 and 12

OAKLAND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (OAK)

These rideshare services pick up passengers outside the baggage claim on the second curb. Fares and travel times vary according to demand and traffic.

TAXIS

SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (SFO)

Taxis depart from the designated taxi zones located at the roadway center islands, on the Arrivals/Baggage Claim Level of all terminals. Uniformed taxi coordinators are stationed at the taxi zones from 7:00 a.m. to 2:15 a.m. to assist passengers with questions or concerns.

Rates and Charges

A \$4.00 exit surcharge is included in all San Francisco taxicab meter fares for rides originating from San Francisco International Airport. The surcharge does not apply to rides dropping off at SFO. By sharing a ride, up to 5 persons can ride for the price of 1 person.

Fare Range: \$44.62 - 64.62

OAKLAND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (OAK)

There are 15 taxi services that pickup outside of the baggage claim area. More information can be found <u>here</u>.

Estimated Fare: \$76.80

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION - BAY AREA RAPID TRANSIT (BART)

This regional rail network offers trains from both the San Francisco airport and the Oakland airport into downtown San Francisco.

At SFO: The SFO BART Station is located on the Departures/Ticketing Level of the International Terminal (G Gates side). BART is easily accessed from any terminal by riding SFO's AirTrain to the Garage G/BART Station stop. There is no charge to board AirTrain.

At OAK: BART is located directly across from Terminal 1 in the baggage claim. Take BART from OAK to Coliseum Station, then board a San Francisco/Daly City-bound train.

BART fares are based on distance traveled; the greater the distance, the higher the fare. A one-way fare from SFO to downtown San Francisco is \$11.15, from OAK to downtown San Francisco is \$12.65. (These fares are subject to change and possible differences depending on the time of day.)


You must either purchase a plastic Clipper Card to use the system or you can use Google Pay or Apple Pay on your phone. You can buy a Clipper Card at the airport BART Stations. A Clipper Card can be used on BART and the MUNI (the downtown bus and train system), and the famous San Francisco cable cars.

Buy your Clipper Card at the SFO or OAK BART stations and load the card with the necessary fare. Place your card at the designated slot on an entry gate, walk through, and proceed to

the platform. When you arrive at your destination, you must scan your Clipper Card again to exit the station. If you don't have enough to exit, don't worry. You can add more at the Add Fare machine in the station.

The closest downtown BART station to the Hilton San Francisco Union Square is Powell Street Station. There are two main ways to walk to the hotel, both shown on the map. Google estimates the walk time as 3 or 4 minutes to the closest hotel entrance.

Be aware that the walk does have a modest uphill.



The recommended route would be to head north up Cyril Magnin Street (past the entrance to the Parc 55 hotel), make a left on Ellis Street, and then a right on Mason Street and enter the hotel through the Mason Street entrance. This will put guests in the garage, where they can walk across the garage and to the Tower 3 elevators.

Alternatively, attendees can continue up Mason Street and make a left on O'Farrell Street, to enter through the hotel's main doors.
